**First Reading: Dan 7:9-10, 13-14**

As I watched,  
thrones were set in place,  
and an Ancient One took his throne,  
his clothing was white as snow,  
and the hair of his head like pure wool;  
his throne was fiery flames,  
and its wheels were burning fire.  
A stream of fire issued  
and flowed out from his presence.  
A thousand thousands served him,  
and ten thousand times ten thousand stood attending him.  
The court sat in judgment,  
and the books were opened.  
As I watched in the night visions,  
I saw one like a human being  
coming with the clouds of heaven.  
And he came to the Ancient One  
and was presented before him.  
To him was given dominion  
and glory and kingship,  
that all peoples, nations, and languages  
should serve him.  
His dominion is an everlasting dominion  
that shall not pass away,  
and his kingship is one  
that shall never be destroyed.

**Second Reading: 2 Pet 1:16-19**

For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we had been eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received honor and glory from God the Father when that voice was conveyed to him by the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is my Son, my Beloved, with whom I am well pleased." We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven, while we were with him on the holy mountain. So we have the prophetic message more fully confirmed. You will do well to be attentive to this as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.

**Psalm 99**

1 The Lord is king; let the people tremble; \*  
he is enthroned upon the Cherubim; let the earth shake.  
**2 The Lord is great in Zion; \*  
he is high above all peoples.**  
3 Let them confess his name, which is great and awesome; \*  
he is the Holy One.  
**4 "O mighty King, lover of justice,  
you have established equity; \*  
you have executed justice and righteousness in Jacob."**  
5 Proclaim the greatness of the Lord our God  
and fall down before his footstool; he is the Holy One.  
**6 Moses and Aaron among his priests,  
and Samuel among those who call upon his name, \*  
they called upon the Lord, and he answered them.**  
7 He spoke to them out of the pillar of cloud; \*

you were a God who forgave them,  
yet punished them for their evil deeds."**  
9 Proclaim the greatness of the Lord our God  
and worship him upon his holy hill; \*  
for the Lord our God is the Holy One.
